Note: This would be cute with a child's name on the tin cans and hung above their bedroom door. If you don't want a banner use the tin cans to hold art supplies.

The Steps

- 1. Wash tin cans make sure there are on sharp edges.
- 2. Tap holes in top edge of tin cans with nail. One hole on each side
- 3. Paint "SUMMER" one letter on each can
- 4. Thread twine though holes. Careful of any sharp edges
- 5. Add cup hooks above door
- 6. Cut flowers to arrange in tin cans
- 7. Add flowers using duct tape to hold in place
- 8. Tie loops in the ends of twine
- 9. Hang banner
